OFSTED

I just wanted to say another thank you for all of your support with our OFSTED inspection last week. The outcome is confidential until the report is officially published and this will be around the start of the summer holidays. We will share this with you as soon as it is available on the OFSTED website. The inspector said he very much enjoyed speaking to pupils, parents and staff during his time at our school.

School Dinners

The governors of the school met last week and reviewed the price of our school dinners. It was noted that these had not changed in five years and it was felt that, in light of the significant rise in food, energy and staffing costs, that we needed to increase the price of dinners in the primary school and preschool. From September 2023, the price of a school meal will be £2.75 and a meal in preschool will be £1.65. We very much recognise that this is a challenging time for all families and hope you understand our reasoning behind these changes.

We have received a donation of £500 from the village website which also contributed to the cost of the library furniture. We always appreciate the support given by our local community are very grateful for such donations which help us improve our learning environment.

Parent Carer Forum Devon survey for families of pupils with SEND
